
Sprnklr—Born By Princeton Tube Spring Reverb

Owner's Manual (#001-)

Thank you for choosing the **Sprnklr** Reverb pedal! Please take a moment to read through this guide to get the most out of this musical wonder-box. It's designed to make your sound spacious, airy, and liquid, taking you back in time—whether it's those carefree surfing days or the early Fleetwood era, where nature's wonder met the power and powder of rock music.



- **Sprnklr** offers classic Fender Princeton Reverb-styled tones in a compact design with simple controls. Easily create airy, spacey sounds with unique character by exploring different settings to find your preferred tone.
- Experiment with control combinations to discover the pedal's full potential even if the layout/controls are pretty self-explanatory. And pair it with an inspiring overdrive pedal (preferable pre Sprnklr), like any <u>Himmelstrutz pedal</u> for even more tonal variety/dimensions—and of course Sprnklr also pairs perfectly with any <u>Himmelstrutz amp!</u>
- **Sprnklr** is handcrafted in Sweden: each pedal is carefully designed, built, tested, and tuned by the original designer.
- If you open the bottom plate and find internal controls, avoid frequent adjustments to protect the pedal's functionality and warranty.
- **Sprnklr** supports usage of a 9 volt battery (6LR61/optional). Though we instead recommend using a 9 to 12 V regulated DC power supply adapter due to the high power usage (circa 0,5 watts), meaning a battery will not last very long. To install a battery: remove the bottom plate, attach the battery to the battery connector, and reattach the plate. Always use the pedal with the bottom plate secured—and always use ear protection when playing loud!
